Gospel Choir Concert Concludes LSTC's New Chapel Music Series

Keith Hampton will lead LSTC's Gospel Choir in the final concert of the new Chapel Music Series on Sunday, April 23 at 4 p.m. The concert is a benefit for the Grover Wright and the Rev. Carole Burns scholarship funds. A freewill offering will be gathered.

The nine-concert Chapel Music Series is the work of Daniel Schwandt, LSTC's staff musician, and Mark Bangert, John H. Tietjen Chair of Pastoral Ministry: Worship and Church Music. Ranging from classical to contemporary and encompassing both sacred and secular music, the series includes recitals, liturgies and concerts.

The first half of the season included recitals by the Murasaki Duo (cello and piano) and Andrew J. Kotylo, winner of the 2005 Ruth and Paul Manz Organ Scholarship. Advent Lessons and Carols in December featured LSTC's Chapel Singers. In January Bangert led Bach for the Sem, the annual benefit concert for LSTC, at the Evangelical Lutheran Church of St. Luke on Chicago's north side.

The Augustana College Choir (Sioux Falls, S.D.) performed in LSTC's Augustana Chapel on January 31.

In addition to the Gospel Choir Concert, remaining performances include: "Sounding the Sacred 2" by the contemporary music ensemble, CUBE, on February 19 at 4 p.m., in its second appearance in the Augustana Chapel. Tickets are \$15 at the door.
